

WORLD APPEAL TO SET THE PLANET FREE FROM ANY WEAPONS OF MASS DESTRUCTION

We, citizens of the world, hope for the planet to be cleared of every nuclear, biological, chemical or latest weapon of mass destruction.

We don't want the international relations to be ruled by the threat of mass slaughters nor our generations and the future generations to perish or survive in a world turned radioactive and unbearable.

We don't want the race for weapons to go on for the benefit of unscrupulous multinational companies or managers eager for power and to the detriment of the rest of humanity.

That's why we demand that the USA, Russia, the United-Kingdom, China and France should honour the "*unequivocal undertaking*" they signed in New York on May 19th, 2000, "*to accomplish the total elimination of their nuclear arsenals leading to nuclear disarmament to which all States parties are committed under Article VI*" of the Non Proliferation Treaty.

As this "*unequivocal undertaking*" has not received any beginning of accomplishment yet, we want the next president of the French Republic and the next French government to instigate real international talks in order to achieve this goal in a progressive, global and strictly controlled way.

Right now, we give our support to Jean-Marie Matagne, president of Action of the Citizens for Nuclear Disarmament (ACDN), the only candidate so far who made this goal the very foundation of his candidacy for the French presidential election.

We invite the papers and the media to attach to the issue he raises the suitable value proportionate to the seriousness of the problem.

The planet must be set free from any weapons of mass destruction. We invite the elected representatives, the French citizens and every citizen in the world to join around this goal in order to force its achievement.
